Motorcycle Trip Vermont/New Hampshire June 15-20, 2021

The following is just a snapshot of our recent trip to the Green and White Mountains of the greater northeastern regions of the United States. It was Don Wilkert who suggested that we plan a trip to this region. So we put together a game plan and invited anyone who would like to go.

Calling ourselves the "wild hogs", maybe because each of us rode Harleys, the group consisted of Harrison County Sheriff's Office Sgt. Curt Diaz who was our "navigator"; new comer Bob Partain was our "weather predictor"; Ronnie Watson, II, designated as our "road safety PIC"; Chuck Martin was the group's "official photographer"; Don Wilkert our "tail twister"; and yours truly "coach" Ron Watson. There is a story behind each of our labels.

Our intent was to ride the quickest highways to Vermont and back home from New Hampshire. So this meant the Interstates. On Tuesday, June 15th, we departed the Fairmont Cracker Barrel at 8:00 am and rode over 500 miles and overnighted in the quaint little town of Oneonta, NY.

The next morning after breakfast at Gail Morey's Dollhouse (it's not what you think), we hit the road and made it to Vermont where we had lunch at DOTS Restaurant in Wilmington, VT before we started our scenic byways ride up 100 through the Green Mountains. The food was great and

especially the waitress, Lisa, who put Wikert in his place when he asked her what was the meaning of the sign on the wall that read "Whiners Will Be SHOT"? She asked him if he could read the small print which she read for him..... "Republican's and Yankee fans". At that point the game was on and Bob got his two cents in with the table next to us who were from New Jersey when he asked the guy if he was a kept man.....what fun we did have.

Along the way we rode through several small villages and overnighted at the Best Western in Waterbury, VT. We had dinner at the Prohibition Pig.....great BBQ and beer. Next morning we stopped at the home factory for Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream. Tours was closed until fall so we rode on and was 4 miles from Canada when we entered New Hampshire.

The ride through the White Mountains was breath taking. At one point we were at an elevation of over 6,000 feet. We ended the day in Concord, NH where we overnighted for the next two nights at the Fairfield Hotel. Evening meal was at The Common Man and again the food and service was excellent. We also struck up a relationship with a group from New York & New Jersey. They were the production crew for Sesame Street. One of the guys was a window washer and had washed windows 79 stories high.

The next day (Saturday, June 18th) we rode to the World's Oldest Motorcycle Rally in their 98th year at Laconia, NH. One of the highlights was when Curt, Chuck & Ronnie did the BMW demo rides at the New Hampshire Speedway Complex. Ronnie recorded a speed of 125 mph. In the Laconia event area Curt, like the Marine he is, demonstrated at the US Marine Booth that he still had it by doing a number of chin ups for the viewing public.

Along the way we met Tommy Alemany, a brother Blue Knight from BKNY 2. After a full day at Laconia we headed back to the hotel to regroup for the next day's activities.

After breakfast on Sunday found us departing for home. Once we got to Albany, NY, it was Interstate the rest of the way. Kurt did an excellent job in leading the group. He also could put away some food.....lots of food.

As we were a few miles from Scranton, PA, Bob updated us on the upcoming weather. And as usual, he was right on the money. We got soaked and lucked into the Four Points Hotel for the night.

With all due respect, my buddy and best friend Don was not the fastest rider of the group but he was the most improved.

On Sunday, June 20th we hammered down and headed home. Round trip was 1875 miles.
