Chaplain's Corner

A favorite Bible story of children is the story of David and Goliath (I Samuel 17:41ff). The story pits a young shepherd boy with a slingshot against a Philistine giant with body armor and all of the weapons of war. David uses a small river rock in his sling and hits the giant right between the eyes as Goliath's fellow soldiers are laughing over a kid being sent to fight the giant.

While none of us may ever fight a huge bulk in body armor we all have faced and do face "giants" in our lives. These giants often come in the form of typical life challenges, such as our own illness, the illness and loss of someone we love, a sudden change in our financial well-being. Other giants we face on the "battle field" of life are the feelings that rise up within us: feelings of anger and hate, of fear and anxiety, of guilt and self-doubt, even depression and despair. While we try our best to ignore these giants they persistently dilute our contentment and enjoyment of life.

Most of these giants cannot be felled with a smooth river rock. Many are not visible with the eye. Our challenge is to find the strength, courage and wisdom to face them and to stand them down. To do this, like David, we would do well to call upon and to rely upon God more than on our own devices. AA has been the oldest and most successful alcohol treatment program in our nation. AA and those who have gone through the program give a lot of credit to its emphasis on "a higher power." Whatever the giants we face our recognition and commitment to God, or to this "higher power" will also be our most reliable resource.
